It was resolved that the matter of the application to Government for a grant-in-aid towards the erection of Apparatus for the treatment of Spines be left in the hands of the Vice-President Authority to pay monies in account of the Spikes works now being erected

It was resolved that the Architect be empowered to issue the ordinary Certificates of work done and that the amounts of such Certificates be forthwith payable
