That it would be inadvisable to recommend
the Council to accept the proposed Trust
offered by the Happy Valley Company
and that the Manager be so informed
this Council regretting that the existence
of a "Trust" which would be
involved would debar the Trustees from
in any way benefitting the School.
That H.C. the Officer administering the
Government be respectfully invited
to inspect the School at his convenience.
That the accounts amounting to £60.5.6
be approved & passed for payment.
That Mr Lecturer Thomas (claiming the
Surveying Class) be informed that in the
absence of any assurance that his private
engagements will not continue to interfere
with his duties as Lecturer this Council
have no alternative but to ask him to
send in his resignation, failing which that
he be dismissed as Lecturer.
That the Registrar make such steps to
secure the services of a gentleman
as Lecturer in Mining & Surveying
to succeed Mr Thomas.
That the Council be recommended to appoint
Mr Hon. M. G. C. or some
other gentleman as Hon. Solicitor
to the School.
That the Hon. Solicitor be requested

to draft the necessary Instrument for
securing to the School the rights in
perpetuity of the Patent taken out by
Messrs. Serjeant & Wade for the School
of Mines respecting Pyrites Furnace
such rights having been presented by
the Director & Patentees.
