It was then unanimously Resolved
 That the acceptance of the resignation of
 Mr Becherovise as lecturer in Telegraphy be
 not dealt with until the Registrar has an
 opportunity of conferring with that gentleman
 Mr Becherovise being at the time attending his
 Class the Registrar conferred with him and
 reported to the Council accordingly, thereupon
 it was decided

That the Resignation be not accepted
 but that Mr. Becherovise be asked to continue
 in charge of the Class in Telegraphy and that
 he be allowed an Assistant at an Honorarium
 of £7 per night for every night of attendance.
