Formation of Class in Pharmacy & Botany

A long discussion took place  
hereon. The letter from the Secretary to  
the Pharmacy Board was read as also  
provisions of the Act 558, and Mr. Flude  
detailed his conversation with Mr. W.  
Johnson, a member of the Pharmacy  
Board. It was generally admitted  
that the School should be brought as

much as possible into accord with the  
present public requirements in these  
and other subjects, so it was  
moved by Mr. Hoelscher

That Pharmacy and Botany be  
added to the Curriculum of the School  
and that all details in connection with  
the proposed addition be left in the  
hands of a Committee consisting of  
Messrs. Peshaw, Flude and Hamard

to future Meetings, some conversation  
ensued without it being decided as  
to its being advisable or otherwise.
