Present Mr G. O. Freshaw, in the Chair,
and Councillors Hoelscher, Hude, Usher M.D.,
and the Registrar. - The Vice-President absent from
indisposition: - Mr Caselli's absence was apologised for.

Business - 1. To meet a Deputation of
Students, (Chemistry Class) re Petition.

2. To consider certain appointments
viz: - Lecturer in Materia Medica, and Examiners
(temporary) in Mathematics and Mining & Land
Surveying.

3. To consider the matter of Site.

4. Document from the Bendigo
School of Mines.

1. Deputation from Students in Chemistry
Class, consisting of Messrs: W. H. Nicholls,
J. B. Gray, and F. J. Martell having been heard
at length, it was resolved: -

1 1/2 hrs

"That on the requisition of not
less than six Students, each paying an additional
fee of one Guinea per Term, the Laboratories
shall be opened for Students' practice from
11 to 4 P.M. on such days as shall be fixed
for the class lectures attended by the Students
signing the Requisition"

necessity for the Examiners' appointments
had passed away, the son of one of the
