Present — The Vice-President in the Chair
Councillors Ch. Koelscher, R. W. Newman, J. F. Baker, M. D.,
and W. H. Barnard.

Business: — To consider Syllabus issued from
Education Department and to make necessary
arrangements for teaching all the Subjects
mentioned in Syllabus.

It was unanimously Resolved:

1^o That the Syllabus be adopted
by the School and steps taken to teach
all of the Subjects included in same

2^o That with a view to secure a
suitable staff of lecturers, the Registrar
write to the Ministry of Education to
ascertain what subsidy will be available
for maintenance

3^o That the Registrar also
communicate with Messrs. Victor Hurray
& Co. to learn what arrangements if any can
be made with those gentlemen as to
taking Cases in some of the Subjects included
in the Syllabus

It was agreed that the lecturers
in Mathematics, Surveying and the
Syllabus subjects be if possible
placed on a more permanent footing
than has been the case heretofore with lecturers.
