The Registrar reported

That he had according to the wish
of the Council again gone to Melbourne and
obtained some such gifts: he had also
waited on the Government (introduced by
the Hon. the Minister of Education) re
obtaining one of the Accuses at the
Exhibition: it appeared that the price
paid by Government to the Commissioners
would amount to an average of £500 each
that the cost of taking down, carting, and
re-erecting, would be about £400 not
restoring foundations or alterations.

That Mr. Preskaw had removed

and hoped that the result would be the
withdrawal of the resignation.

That the Government had requested
that the Tower should not be built on
