A meeting of Examiners of Engineers convened for the purpose of preparing Question-paper for Engine-drivers examination was held at 8 O'clock p.m., Thursday, 1st June 1882

The Chairman pointed out that only two examiners (Mr Richards and himself, both engaged in the same firm) attended the last meeting, and prepared the last examination paper; and objected to accepting the onus of preparing Question-papers unless a fuller attendance of Examiners be secured. - Mr Berry was requested to ask the consideration of the Administrative Council to the matter with a view to the adoption of remedial measures either by increasing the number of Examiners or otherwise

Mr Keast moved Mr Richards seconded, and it was carried

That the Examiners absent from this meeting be communicated with to the effect that it is very desirable that they should attend the meetings convened for the preparation of Examination papers; Also, That three Examiners shall form a quorum for the preparation, or examination, of Question-papers.
