Appointment of Auditor:- C<sup>r</sup> Caselli moved that Mr Charles Kent be appointed Auditor for the present year - Seconded by C<sup>r</sup> Becherwaise and carried.

The reports of Visiting Committee for the past month were read and on the motion of C<sup>r</sup> Becherwaise seconded by C<sup>r</sup> Rosenblum, C<sup>r</sup> Martell, and Nicholls appointed for the ensuing month

Half-yearly examinations:- The Acting Registrar was instructed to write, reminding C<sup>r</sup> Nicholls, and Figgis of their appointment together with Professor Smith to arrange for the conduct of these examinations

C<sup>r</sup> Becherwaise moved, C<sup>r</sup> Caselli seconded, and it was carried, that it be left with the Vice-President to make arrangements for the presentation of illuminated address to Mr Barnard

A letter from Mr Barnard complying with a request from the Vice President to hand over a cheque for £129.4.9 amount of Pyrites Fund of The School deposited in the Union Bank to Credit of Mr Barnard - was read, and on the motion of C<sup>r</sup> Becherwaise, seconded by C<sup>r</sup> Rosenblum it was resolved that the Pyrites Fund be an item of the business for consideration at the next Quarterly meeting of the Council.

It was resolved on the motion of C<sup>r</sup> Rosenblum seconded by C<sup>r</sup> Becherwaise that it is desirable the Laboratory Classes should be conducted on Wednesday evenings in addition to the evenings on which the Students now meet - and that the Visiting Committee confer with Professor Smith with a view to making arrangements for carrying out the wishes of the Council
