

The Accounts amounting to £235.19.8 were passed for payment on the motion of C^r Caselli seconded by C^r Becherwaize Astronomical Class. C^r Rosenblum moved C^r Caselli seconded and it was carried "That this Class form an integral part and be conducted under the auspices of The School.

On the motion of C^r Nicholls seconded by C^r Becherwaize the Registrar was instructed to direct the attention of the Lecturers to confine themselves to the requisitioned supplies for six months already approved by the Council.

C^r Rosenblum suggested that with a view to facilitate the business of the Council the Finance Committee meet to examine the Accounts on the evening preceding the day fixed for meeting of Administrative Council.

C^r Nicholls moved that every Student be recommended to supply themselves with apparatus required for laboratory practice the regulation to come into operation at the beginning of next year; C^r Rosenblum seconded and it was carried.

Scientific Instruments. - C^r Becherwaize reported that he had not consulted with Mr Figgis and requested the Registrar to call them together for consideration of the matter.

Redistribution of Terms. - This was left to C^r Figgis & Nicholls for final settlement. - These Councillors were also requested to enquire why the laboratories were closed to Students on Wednesday afternoons and to arrange with the Professor to meet the wishes of the Students in the desired alteration of hours for practical work.

C^r Becherwaize reported that in company with C^r Nicholls he had waited on the manager of the Union Bank and ascertained that interest could be obtained on moneys lodged therein. C^r Nicholls moved C^r Caselli seconded and it was carried, That a sum of money be deposited at interest on receipt of the next instalment of £1000.

C^r Rosenblum moved that the Gas Engine and machinery

ordered by the Council be stored until a complete plan had been prepared and buildings erected for their reception; C^r Nicholls seconded and it was carried.

Chilium Mill. On the motion of C^r Rosenblum seconded by C^r Martell the order for this was postponed.

C^r Becherwaize moved that the laboratory furnaces be repaired under the direction of C^r Caselli; also that a copy of Huxley's Physiology be obtained for Dr Hoher's Class and that authority be given for procuring and spreading 2 loads of fine gravel on the pathway around the main building. Carried.

The Registrar was instructed to request Mr Figgis to leave open for a further period an offer which he had made to the Council re laboratory apparatus.

On the motion of C^r Becherwaize seconded by C^r Caselli, the Council assented that a collection be prepared and forwarded to Prof. Huxley as suggested by Prof. Krause.

It was resolved on the motion of C^r Rosenblum seconded by C^r Becherwaize that the Books and Accounts be audited half-yearly.

Student-Assistants. The Vice-President explained the steps which had been taken towards securing the services of student-assistants and his action was confirmed on the motion of C^r Rosenblum seconded by C^r Martell.

The Registrar was authorised to have Time Tables printed; also 500 Cards for Collector at a cost of 25/-
