

A requisition for supplies of tools and material for class in applied Electricity and Magnetism was referred together with a recommendation to purchase certain electrical apparatus to the sub-Committee Scientific Instruments, with power.

A letter from Professor Krause applying for an increased stipend was read. - On the motion of C^r Caselli, Councillors Becheweise, Nicholls, and Rosenblum were deputed to confer, inquire and report thereon at next meeting of Administrative Council. -

Auditor's report was read, received, and adopted. -

A communication from M^r Wooster offering to give a lecture at The School was read and the Registrar instructed to reply.

On the motion of C^r Rosenblum seconded by C^r Nicholls it was resolved that the Education Department be applied to for the services of an Officer to design and superintend the erection of the proposed additional buildings in connection with The School. -

C^r Nicholls reported that 106 of the pupils attending the Science Classes at this Institution from State Schools presented for examination on Wednesday last.

It was resolved that all Students of The School during the last (April) Term be invited to a re-union in the Lecture Hall on Friday evening 13th July instant.

The Registrar was instructed to keep a list of paid students posted in the laboratories each Term.

C^r Becheweise and Rosenblum were appointed a Visiting Committee for the ensuing month.

Meeting of Scientific Instruments Sub Committee
Tuesday 4 P.M. July 10th 1883.

Present the Vice-President in the Chair Councillors W. P. Becheweise and S. E. Liggins. - The requisition for tools and material required for Class in applied Electricity and Magnetism submitted at meeting of Administrative Council on the 17th instant and referred to this Committee with power was considered and the various items agreed to. - M^r Sutton was in attendance and stated that the electrical instruments included in the list which he had submitted with a recommendation for the Council to purchase could now be obtained in the English market at little more than half the usual cost and the Registrar was instructed to order the supply. -

A memorandum from M^r Burbridge accompanied by a suggestion from Prof. Krause re purchase of some mechanical models was submitted and referred for consideration of the Council at the quarterly meeting to be held 11th June instant.
