## Astronomical Notes.

**PLANETS.**—The sun enters the constellation Cancer on the 18th; his distance from the earth at noon of the 1st 94,449,000 miles, which is nearly his greatest distance, as he will be in apogee at 2 p m of the 4th. Venus, Mars, and Jupiter are visible in the evening, Mercury and Saturn in the morning. ## Garden Notes for the Month.

### FLOWERS.

Planting, digging, and other operations on the soil should, if possible, be brought to a close before the end of the month. Finish the necessary pruning of hardy shrubs; prune and train climbers on walls and trellises; roses also may be pruned. Examine plant labels, and renew those that are worn out. Prepare the soil of lawns for sowing with couch grass, or planting with buffalo grass, by digging and levelling.

### VEGETABLES.

In light, dry, warm soils and situations, potatoes may be freely planted of the early varieties, such as early rose, vermout, ash leaf, fluke, &c. In good rich soil, deeply cultivated, peas may be sown largely. The Variety known as the Yorkshire hero is very good for general cropping. Onions—brown globe, Strasburg, Danvers yellow—can be sown for a main crop, and silver-skinned for pickling purposes; spinach (round and prickly), radishes, and small salads, such as mustard and cress. This is a good time to make sowings of turnips, parsnips, and carrots (scarlet intermediate).
