to prepare the Statute prescribing the examination,
and defining the persons to be brought under it
Carried

Moved by Mr McDowall seconded by Mr Flude

That the Statute prescribing the hours of meeting
of the Council & Administrative Council be so
amended as to admit of such Councils
meeting at any hour of the day - Carried.

Moved by Mr McDowall seconded by Mr Flude
That this meeting stand adjourned to this
day four weeks at the same place and hour
Carried
