The report of the Board of Examiners of Students for Stage Certificates and of State School Science Classes was submitted and adopted on the motion of C^r Martell seconded by C^r Figgis - Stage Certificates to be awarded as follow: - Chemistry - First Stage - John Irwin, W. R. Becherwise, W. F. Roberts, P. J. McCarthy, David Avery and Frederick Given; Chemistry - Second Stage - J. R. Bradshaw, and Stephen Harris; Metallurgy - First Stage - W. R. Becherwise, John Martelli, & W^m Selow; Geology - First Stage - Arthur E. Hoque; Electricity and Magnetism, First Stage - J. S. Morrison; Free Scholarships to be awarded - W. R. Becherwise for Metallurgy, John Irwin for Chemistry, and Ernest Heinrichsen, for any Science subject; Prizes to be awarded - Barbara Ramsay, Lizzie Clarke, M. Ramsay, Miss^{Justice} Latter, and Miss^{Henry} Burrows

The report also recommended that a Free Scholarship should be awarded to the first in the combined written and practical examination of the State School Class in Electricity and Magnetism.

On the motion of C^r Martell seconded by C^r Figgis, S. Liddian Esq. M. A., was appointed an examiner in mathematical subjects.

C^r Martell moved that the resolution passed on the 15th August last fixing the Term Fee for instruction in Telegraphy at £2. 2/- be rescinded - Seconded by C^r Mann and carried.

His Lordship the Bishop moved that the sum of £25 be granted to Professor Haunse supplementary to the emoluments received for the past six months, - Seconded by C^r Mann and carried.

On the motion of C^r Jones, seconded by C^r Figgis, a very cordial vote of thanks was passed to M^r John Wall for conducting gratuitously, two Classes in Astronomy at The School since May 1883; and it was resolved that an advertisement be inserted with a view to the formation of an adult Class paying Fees for instruction

On the motion of C^r Martell seconded by C^r Figgis, it was resolved that the architects be instructed to proceed at once with the erection of the new buildings under the direction of a Building Committee comprising the Vice-President; Councillors Figgis and Nicholls.

Contract of Sale, Wesleyan Church Property - His Lordship the Bishop moved C^r Jones seconded and it was carried, 'That the Seal of The School be attached to this document'

On the motion of C^r Martell seconded by C^r Jones the allowance for audit fees for the past year was fixed at £5. 5/- The Council then adjourned.
