Special Meeting of the Council of the Council

Wednesday 14. 30 P.M.
November 14th 1883.

Present - The Vice President in the Chair, Councillors the Hon. James Campbell J.P., S. E. Figgis, J. J. Jones J.P., J. Mann, B. J. Martell, W. H. Nicholls, Theo. Williams J.P., and E. J. Rosenblum

Business:-

1. To fill up *pro tem* the vacancies in the Administrative Council caused by the retirement of Messrs. W. P. Bechervaise and H. R. Caselli, J.P.
2. To appoint Honorary Treasurer.
3. To determine the accuracy of the resolution passed at Special Meeting of the Council, held 19th October, ultimo, referring to the New Buildings to be erected and the utilizing of the Cottage for Offices.
4. To resolve upon the action to be taken.

C^r Rosenblum moved that Councillors the Right Reverend Dr. Thornton and Thos. Mann B.A. be appointed to fill the vacancies in the Administrative Council caused by the retirement of Messrs Bechervaise and Caselli
Seconded by C^r Campbell and carried.

C^r Nicholls moved that C^r J. J. Jones J.P., be appointed Honorary Treasurer to the institution - Seconded by C^r Campbell and Carried

C^r Rosenblum moved that the Plan prepared for the new buildings by the Architects Messrs Caselli and Figgis and marked N^o 1 be adopted with the following alterations viz: (1) That the width of the new building (to be erected in brickwork) be increased so as to leave a right-of-way of (5) five feet from the iron fence of the Gaol reserve; (2) That the building be reduced in length as little as possible - the reduction to be made at the eastern end; (3) That a door be inserted in the south wall; (4) That two offices be provided for in the western end of the lower storey; and (5) That all other matters such as the choice of roof, &c, be left to the discretion of the Administrative Council. - Seconded by C^r Martell and carried unanimously

C^r Campbell moved that the engine and machinery be placed in an annex outside the main building at the eastern end the total cost of the two buildings not to exceed £ 2000. - Seconded by C^r Rosenblum and carried.

C^r Rosenblum moved that the Vice-President, C^r Mann, Nicholls, and the mover be appointed a sub-committee to confer with the trustees of the Wesleyan Church reserve with a view to purchasing the property now offered for sale and to report thereon to the Council. Seconded by C^r Martell and carried.

C^r Campbell moved that the Architects be instructed to prepare plans and specifications for the new buildings in accordance with the resolutions passed at this meeting and that a special meeting of the Administrative Council be convened to receive the same and order thereon. Seconded by C^r Nicholls and carried.

C^r Figgis moved that the resolution marked N^o 1 on minutes of Special meeting of the Council held 19th October ultimo be now rescinded. Seconded by C^r Nicholls and carried
