Business: - To pass Accounts and to transact ordinary business

Minutes of previous meeting held 4<sup>th</sup> February ultimo were read and confirmed on the motion of C<sup>o</sup> Reid seconded by C<sup>o</sup> Williams

Accounts paid since last meeting amounting to £178. 9. 8 were confirmed, and Accounts presented amounting to £329. 8. 3 were passed for payment on the motion of C<sup>o</sup> Williams seconded by C<sup>o</sup> Jones - payment of Mr. Fly's account for £213. 9. 4 to be conditional on a guaranty from the Architects that when the shrinkage has ceased the floors shall be adjusted free of extra charge

A Circular from Chief Secretary re Colonial and Indian Exhibition to be held in London in 1886 was referred to the Professors with a request that the same receive attention.
