Ordinary Meeting of Administrative Council } Wednesday 4.30 P.M.
June 3rd 1885.

Present - Councillors E. J. Rosenblum (in the chair),
J. J. Jones, J. P., F. J. Martell, H. Reid and R. J. Vale.

An apology was received for the absence of His
Lordship the Bishop of Ballarat.

Minutes of previous meeting held 6th May ultimo
were read and confirmed on the motion of Mr Jones.

Accounts paid since last meeting being Arrearages,
Salaries & Wages for May amounting to £171. 1. 2
and Accounts presented 63. 2. 7
making a total of £234. 3. 9 were confirmed and
passed for payment.

Accounts amounting to £50. 12/- for work done in
connection with the Church building having been received
this day were referred to the Buildings Committee and
Finance Committee.

It was resolved that the thermometers be protected
from damage by wire netting; also, that the office
formerly occupied by Professor Smith be fitted up as
specified in his memorandum for a workshop, and that
a gas bracket be fixed in office in new laboratory, the
work to be executed under the direction of the Buildings
Committee.

Councillors F. J. Martell, and E. J. Rosenblum, were
appointed visiting Committee for the ensuing month.

Mr Martell moved "That in future the examinations
in Telegraphy be divided into two parts, the theoretical
and the practical; that Certificates be granted for
either; and that a student failing to pass in one

part shall be allowed to present at any following
examination, for examination in that part without
further fee.
