4. - (a) The recommendations submitted by the Mechanical Committee were read and approved. Mr Reid handed in a number of letters received in reply to a Circular that had been distributed with a view to eliciting opinions from experts for the information of the Council. - It was resolved that the whole matter be referred to the Mechanical Committee - the names of Mr Bickett and the Hon. Treasurer to be added to the Committee
- (b) The Report of the Professorial Board recommending that an optical lantern with accessories be procured was also approved and referred to the above Committee
- (c) Mineralogical Laboratory - It was decided that a general plan of buildings required for the whole school be obtained before erecting any more buildings, and that the Buildings Committee be empowered to take steps to procure the same
5. - Auditor's Report with Statement of Receipts and Expenditure for the year 1883 were submitted, received, and adopted. -
6. - The Hon. Treasurer presented an Estimate of the income and expenditure for the current year as follows.
- Receipts - Government Subsidy £2000; Fees £650;

Public Subscriptions £200; Sundries £50; Total £2900.

Expenditure - Salaries & Wages £2200; Maintenance and Miscellaneous £860; Total £3060. - In view of this deficiency and the numerous requirements for efficient work it was resolved on the motion of Mr Wynne, seconded and supported by Mr Reid and Bickett "That application be made to the Government for a Grant of £4000 to meet the requirements of The School for the current year". -

7. - On the motion of Mr Reid the following Committee was appointed to meet the Committee appointed by the University in conference on the affiliation question: - His Lordship the Bishop, the Ven. Archdeacon, the mayors of the City and Town, J. M. Bickett, J. J. Jones, F. J. Martell, W. H. Nicholls, E. J. Rosenblum, and A. Wynne.

8. - Referred to Education Committee together with application from A. Semple to establish classes in German.

9. - It was decided to co-operate with Sandhurst in an application for a special Grant for Museum purposes in accordance with resolution of Administrative Council 9th Dec^r.
