Accounts paid since last meeting being Honorariums,
Salaries and Wages for the month and for the quarter
ended 31st March £196.5.0 were confirmed and the
Accounts presented amounting to £55.17.2 were passed
for payment subject to approval of the Finance Committee
exceptions being taken to the charge of £2 Water rate for
hydrant fixed near the museum and £1 for repairing the
mercurial column in the Lower

The monthly Progress reports for March submitted
by the Professors and Lecturers were adopted. Authority
was granted to employ a man (laborer) for a few days
to clean up the walks and grounds and a requisition for
Chemicals and apparatus &c amounting to £

The Registrar was instructed to comply with the
suggestions of the Railway Commissioners in obtaining the
signatures and address of students at the commencement of
each quarter prior to granting railway tickets at the rates
allowed by the Department
