To receive and consider Report of Education Committee, recommending—

- (1). That Mr. Gilbert J. Dawbarn, B.Sc., be offered an appointment under conditions that the whole of his time and services be devoted to the duties of lecturing in connection with The School.
- (2). That the Agreement between The School and the Curator be altered so as to remove the present condition under which the Council is entitled to share one half of the fees received by him in the course of private practice, and providing that the time to be occupied in private practice shall not exceed one day in a week, and shall not interfere with School duties.
- (3). That the present Lecturer on Astronomy be notified that his services will cease to be required at the end of the current Term.
- (4). That only apprentices to mechanical trades in receipt of wages less than ten shillings per week be granted any concession of Fees for instruction in Drawing, and the privilege of attending the Mathematical class free of extra charge.
- The report of the Education Committee was read and the recommendation that Mr Dawbarn be offered an appointment was adopted; the matter to be left in the hands of the Committee with power to complete the final arrangements.
