


"ten shillings and under" be substituted for the words "less than ten shillings".

December 5th 1887.

Present - The Vice-President in the Chair Councillors the Ven. Archdeacon Julius, His Worship the Mayor of Ballarat East, J. J. Jones, J. P. and F. J. Martell
Minutes of previous meeting held 7th November ultimo were read and confirmed.

Accounts paid since previous meeting, £180.13.6 and Accounts presented amounting to £74.12.9 making a total of £255.6.3 were passed for payment.

Progress Reports for the month of November were submitted from the Lecturers on Mathematics, and Drawing respectively.

The more important Correspondence was read and received. - In regard to a Communication received from the Mining Department it was resolved to invite Mining Companies by advertisement to assist The School in bringing together a good mineral Collection to represent the geology and mining industry of the Colony, at the Centennial International Exhibition of 1888; and that Professor Krause be requested to use his utmost endeavours to secure and prepare a suitable collection worthy of The School.

Mr Gilbert J. Dawbarn B.Sc., was introduced to the Council and submitted credentials of his qualifications, including a copy of the Glasgow University Calendar for the year 1885-86. - Mr Dawbarn intimated his willingness to accept a lectureship at The School, and on the motion of the Hon. Treasurer seconded by Mr Martell it was resolved that he be appointed to fill the position of lecturer to the mechanical engineering class, and in such other subjects as may be found necessary to meet the requirements of The School, and computable with
