### BUSINESS:

- 1.—To receive report of Board of Examiners, and determine the awards.
- 2.—To consider and determine in regard to letting the use of certain rooms at The School for teaching purposes.
- 3.—To receive Hon. Treasurer's Estimates of Receipts and Expenditure, and apportion the Salaries for the Current Year.

And to consider such other matters as the Vice-President may submit.

1.—An explanation of the system pursued by the Board of Examiners in recommending free instruction scholarships received from Professor Smith was considered satisfactory and the Report of the Board as previously submitted was adopted.
