Minutes of previous meeting held 15th December ult.
were read and confirmed.

Accounts paid since previous meeting £376.2.8
were confirmed and the accounts presented amounting
to £77.8.1 making a total of £453.10.9 were
passed for payment.

The Correspondence inwards included a communication
from the Vice-President re transferring The School's
Banking Account from the Union to the City of
Melbourne Bank. - It was resolved to submit the
matter for favorable consideration to the full Council.

A memorandum from Professor Smith containing
proposals that the fee for each senior all-day student
in Chemistry and Metallurgy be increased to £4.4.0
per term, and that all students be required to provide
not only their own apparatus but the more expensive
re-agents and materials, also, that advanced students
be required to provide their own boxes of weights, platinum
and silver crucibles and agate mortars, was read.

It was resolved to refer the question of increasing the
fees to the full Council, and to adopt the recommendations
in regard to apparatus and material, including the
issue of entrance Cards or slips to students for presentation
to the lecturer.

A request for authority to incur an expenditure of
about £10 in renovating the alcove in the museum submitted
by Professor Krause was agreed to.

Applications for increased emoluments received from
Mr Lecturer Dawson and the Office Assistant were
postponed for consideration at next meeting. -

The Registrar was instructed in regard to replies to
other correspondence.
