Present - The President in the Chair, Vice-President F. J. Martell Councillors S. E. Figgis and J. Louie. Apologies for absence were received from His Lordship the Bishop, St. Shelton B.C., and Mr. Lindsey.

Minutes of Joint Meeting of the Council and Administrative Council held on the 11th ultimo were read at this meeting and signed by the President.

Accounts paid since previous meeting £ 380. 6. 0 were confirmed and the accounts presented amounting to £ 88. 18. 4 making a total of £ 469. 4. 4 were passed for payment.

Progress Reports submitted by the Staff were read and the recommendation of Mr Dawson to grant £1 to student Mr Dougall for services rendered in connection with the recent lecture at the Mechanics' Institute was approved.

The Registrar was instructed to convey the thanks of the Council to Mr Dawson for his offer to deliver another lecture also to Messrs Lombard and Maisey for donations of specimens to the Museum. - Professor Smith's report on ventilation of the laboratories, etc., was referred to the visiting Committee for consideration and report. The resignation of Mr Farrer as Assistant Teacher in Mathematics was referred to the Education Committee.

It was resolved that the museum be open to the public in future at 9.30 am.

A letter from the University intimating that the Council would hear a deputation from The School was referred to the Committee appointed to deal with this matter. - Several letters regarding the amount of retaining fee for public analyst were also submitted for consideration.
