Minutes of previous meeting held on the 10th June ultimo were read and confirmed.

Accounts paid since previous meeting £390.6.4 were confirmed and Accounts presented amounting to £106.3.5 making a total of £496.9.9 were passed for payment

Correspondence inwards included the usual monthly Progress Reports submitted by the Staff. - A requisition for six months supply of chemicals estimated cost £53.12.1 was approved the same to be obtained by tender. - The heavy expenditure in connection with the chemical and metallurgical laboratories for the past half-year was referred to and it was resolved that Professor Smith be requested to furnish a report thereon for the information of the Council. - In regard to a requisition for a microscope submitted by Dr Genthail it was resolved to postpone consideration of the same until the amount of subsidy to The School be published and that if the grant to this Institution be not reduced the instrument described be purchased - estimated cost £55.16.0

Auditor's report and Balance Sheet for the half-year ended 30th June were read and received.

It was resolved that Mr Hall be notified that from and after the expiration of the current month the emoluments in connection with his lectureship at this Institution will be at the rate of £100 per annum.
