 of the Council } 28 June 1895

Present The President (in the chair) Vice President
 The Hon R. J. Vale The Hon J. W.
 Waulins. The Hon W. Williams JP Mayor of Ballarat
 East and Messrs Louie JP Figgis Lindsay,
 and Middleton

His Lordship the Bishop moved and Mr
 Lindsay seconded "That this Council, to prevent
 all possible misapprehension on the
 subject, places on record its distinct under-
 standing that, under existing arrangements
 no member of the staff is at liberty to
 enter into any engagements outside the
 School without the express consent of the
 Council being first had and obtained
 in writing; and that a copy of this
 resolution be handed to every member
 of the staff" Carried Unanimously

The Bishop that Prof. Krause's application
 Mr Middleton } be allowed six months leave

Mr Vale } that Prof. Krause be informed
 Mr Lindsay } that his engagement with
 the Melbourne University cannot be
 allowed - Amendment carried

Mr Vale } that Mr Dawson's application for
 Mr Louie } six months leave for the purpose
 of visiting England and America
 be declined.

The Bishop } that the matter be referred to a
 Mr Middleton } subcommittee for enquiry to
 to report to this Council at an early date
 Motion Carried

It was decided to enter a protest against

the Education Department's award of 1570
 merit grant and to forward Mr King's
 letter to the Department

The Director and Registrar was directed to
 inform Mr Sipping C.E. that the Council
 does not see its way to avail itself of Mr.
 Sipping's kind services -
