Minutes of Meeting held 15 Nov were
 read and confirmed.
 Accounts amounting to £353-7-1 were
 passed for payment.

Reports from the Director & Registrar and
 from the Staff were received and
 adopted.

It was decided to add the names of
 Messrs W. E. Blair and Geo. Williams
 to the list of Honorary Correspondents
 in recognition of a case of valuable
 specimens forwarded to the School
 by them from Western Australia.

It was determined to raise Prof.
 Purdie's salary £30 a year in recognition
 of his teaching the Botany classes.

It was decided to invite Dr. Meyer to
 resume charge of the Class in Materia
 Medica, and that the matter be left
 in the President's hands to deal with.

In reply to a letter from Mr L. Hart
 it was resolved to pay him the £15
 asked for, for six months' instruction of
 class in Photography, on the distinct
 understanding that the Council incur
 no liability in future.

The date for the Annual Meeting was fixed
 for ordinary meeting in February.
