The President introduced Mr Geo. Buchanan who then took his seat as a member of Council. The President reported that he had received a letter from T.P. Hon R.D. Vale announcing the death of Mr J. Dement and that he would be absent from the meeting in consequence. The President & Mr. J. M. Bickett both eulogized the good work done for the Schools and Science teaching generally by the late Mr Dement whose death they much deplored.
