 the examinations in Art subjects and
 explaining the inconvenience caused
 by the delay. It was resolved that
 this Council regrets that the results of
 the examinations in Art are not yet
 to hand and trust that they will be

available at an early date and
 further that similar delays will, if possible,
 be avoided in future.
