- (1) To consider four (4) tenders for printing the School's prospectus for the year 1916.
- (2) To consider applications received from Messrs C. A. Hoadley, H. B. Herbert and R. Cetter and Miss Louie for increases in salary.

- (1) It was resolved that Messrs Berry Anderson & Co's tender be accepted.
- (2) It was resolved to submit the following recommendations to the Council:
 - (a) That Mr H. B. Herbert's salary be raised by £50 per annum (fifty pounds) the increase to commence with the new year.
 - (b) That Mr R. Cetter's salary be raised by £25 per annum (twenty five pounds), the increase to commence with the new year.
 - (c) That Mr C. A. Hoadley's salary be increased by £25 per annum (twenty five pounds) until £400 per annum is reached, as per minute of the Council (29.5.1914), the increase to commence with the 1st July, 1915.
 - (d) That Miss Louie's wages be raised by five shillings per week.
