Mr R. T. Vale } The minutes of the meeting held on the 28th January,

Mr G. Fitches } The Principals' Report was received and
Mr J. Saunders } adopted, and after discussion the
following resolutions were adopted:

(a) That Mr J. Martell be requested to give

may have the opportunity of being present
at such meetings.

Mr G. Fitches } (b) That Mr W. H. Collyer's appointment as Lect.
Mr J. Husley } -urer in Engineering be confirmed at a salary
to be paid at the rate of £300 per annum.

(c) That all members present at this meeting
be appointed as a special committee to consider
the details of the arrangements in connexion

with the Distribution of awards on the 3rd April next;
that the first meeting of the committee be held
on Friday the 3rd March 1916 at 8 p.m.

(d) That the reclassification of the staff be
reconsidered and reported on at the next monthly
meeting of the Council.

The Trade Board Report was received and
adopted and it was resolved that a letter be
sent to Mr F. King (the previous chairman
of the Board) thanking him for the active and
loyal service he had rendered to the School during
his term of office.

Mr J. J. Martell's Report was received and
adopted and :-

Mr J. S. Vickery moved and Mr J. Husley seconded that all
returned ~~and~~ wounded soldiers be received
and taught free of cost. The motion was
carried subject to an amendment by the Hon
R. T. Vale, seconded by Mr G. Fitches, that
applications for admission would be
favorably considered by the Council.
