The Report furnished by the Special Committee
appointed to determine the value of Mr Martell's
services was read and discussed. Colonel
Bolton suggested that Mr Martell's services
might be used by the Federal Government
in connexion with the Repatriation Scheme.
Councillor F. Herman moved and Cr. Brokenshire
seconded

" That Mr Martell be paid a fixed salary
of £100 per annum together with 20%
commission on new subscriptions collected

and that a copy of Mr Martell's Report, read at
this meeting, be forwarded to the Minister of Education"
Col. Bolton moved

Cr W. T. Humphreys seconded the following amendment
" That the Council justifies the continued
employment of Mr Martell at a fixed salary
of £100 per annum plus 20% commission
on new subscriptions collected by him."

a further amendment was moved by :-
Cr Lederman

and seconded by Cr A. O. Stubbs as follows :-

" That the matter be deferred until a deputation
from the Council has an opportunity of interviewing
the Minister in order to place before him the
Council's recommendation that Mr Martell be
appointed at a fixed salary of £100 per
