Special meeting of the Finance Committee held on Thursday, 13th December, 1917 at 7.45 p.m. to prepare a statement of Mr Herbert H. Smith's duties in connexion with his new appointment as Principal of the Technical Art School.

Present: The President (Mr W. H. Middleton) in the chair, Councillors R. Maddern, R. S. Turbridge, W. T. Humphreys, J. D. Woolcott.

Ex. 5796 Letters dated 25th October, 1916 and 11th December, 1917 from the Director of Education were read and after discussion the following statement of Mr Smith's duties was adopted.

- (1) That his title be defined as "Principal of the Technical Art School"
- (2) That he is to retain his seat at the Council meetings as formerly.
- (3) That he is to present a separate report at the monthly meetings of the Council, but that the report must be discussed with Mr Copland before it is presented.
- (4) That he is to exercise supervision over the Technical Art School and the allied trade classes as formerly.
- (5) That all departmental correspondence and requisitions for supplies for all departments are to be approved by the Principal of the Institution before being executed.
