It was resolved to forward the applications in view of the difficulty of obtaining a suitable instructor in Australasia to the Education Department and to request permission to re-advertise the position in

The Principal (Mr Colland) explained what had taken place in connexion with the appointment of Mr McLowan to the position of lecturer in Civil Engineering. He also drew attention to the difficulties that had been experienced in obtaining a lecturer in Geology, Mineralogy & Surveying. He expressed a very favorable opinion with regard to the application from Mr Junner and suggested that the salary of the position be raised to £350 per annum.

Resolved that as soon as the applications close to forward same to the Education Department and to state that the Council recommends the appointment of Mr Junner at a salary of £350 per annum.
