To consider what steps should be taken to obtain recognition of the Surveyor's Course at the School by the Municipal Surveyors' Board.

Present: The President (Mr. W. H. Middleton) in the chair, The Principal (Mr. M. Copland) Messrs A. Farrer, L. Finch, L. H. Archibald, Cr. M. Martin, Cr. W. Baragwanath, ~~Cr. D. Mead~~

Mr. Martin suggested that the course should be altered to make it of practical value to the students.

Mr. Copland stated that the course had been originally called a Diploma Course of Municipal and Hydraulic Engineering, which he had altered to Civil Engineering.

Cr. 87. A letter from Mr. G. King (Principal of the Gordon Technical College, Galong) was read in reply to a request from this school for information on the question of recognition of his students.

Cr. Baragwanath. stated that in Dr. Jenner's time, arrangements had been completed with Mr. Mead for employment of students of this school by the Department of Irrigation.

Mr. Copland explained that this arrangement had been impossible to carry out.

A further suggestion was that the course should provide for two years lectures at the school and two years practical experience under a qualified engineer with continued attendance at the school.
