Monthly Meeting of the Council held on Friday 30th July, 1920 at 8 p.m.

Present: The President (Mr W. H. Middleton) in the chair. Vice President - J. S. Vickers, Councillors, F. Saunders, J. Kean, L. Liderman, M. Martin, J. Kelly, and the Art Principal (Mr H. H. Smith).
