Meeting of the Finance and Propaganda Committees held on Monday, 25th July, 1921 in the Council Room at 4 p.m.

Present: The President (Mr W. H. Middleton) in the chair, Vice President J. S. Vickery, Councillors R. Maddern, W. T. Humphreys, The Principal (Mr A. F. Nesbitt), Messrs R. W. Richards, E. J. McConnon, Mr Sutherland, and L. S. G. P. Austin, & L. H. Archibald.

An apology was received from Vice President D. Maxwell.

Consideration was given to the cost of changing the system of advertising. Messrs McConnon & Richards explained that the object of the Propaganda Committee was not to reduce or increase expenditure on advertising but to use the present funds to better advantage by publishing leaflets and other propaganda matter. In this way it was anticipated that more full course students would be attracted to the school. As a result of the discussion the Finance Committee agreed that the Propaganda Committee should take whatever action it considered necessary, without, if possible, increasing the expenditure.

It was also suggested that the City Council should be approached with a view to obtaining an increase in their annual donation for scholarships. Mr Archibald ~~stated~~ considered that the School's position would be much strengthened if more scholarships of this kind were available. It was decided, however, that representations to the City Council should be deferred until the financial position of the Municipality was

more favorable.
