Meeting of the Special Committee held on Thursday, 18<sup>th</sup> August, 1921 at 4.30 p.m. to discuss the programme in connection with the opening ceremony of the Junior Technical School building on 9<sup>th</sup> September <sup>at</sup> and the Fair on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> September

Present: the President (Mr W. Middleton) in the chair Councillors F. Barrow, F. Saunders, the Principal (Mr A. F. Heselline) the A.P. Principal (Mr H. W. Smith) and the headmaster (Mr A. W. Steane) Apologies: Vice Presidents J. S. Vickery, D. Maxwell

- (1) It was decided that the opening ceremony should commence at 2.30 p.m. and the Fair ~~at 5.30~~ held until 10 p.m. on each day.
  - (2) That Sir Alexander Peacock K.C.M.G. be invited to perform the opening ceremony.
  - (3) That the Director of Education (Mr F. Jaki) the Chief Inspector of Technical Schools (Mr D. Clark) the A.P. Inspector (Mr Carrow Smith) & Major the Honorable Mr. Baird be invited to give addresses.
  - (4) That the general invitations should include: <sup>School Council</sup> Presidents & Principals of Technical Schools, Junior Technical Schools, <sup>Head Masters or Headresses</sup> Local Secondary & High Schools, City Councillors, <sup>Local</sup> School Board Councillors, Members of Parliament. Separate invitations to headmasters of State Schools & one <sup>inclusion</sup> invitation to Staffs of each school & the Head Master of the Geelong Grammar School, Corio.
- With regard to Refreshments it was decided that <sup>a tally should be kept of</sup> the visitors taking refreshments at the Fair & the amount per head refunded by the Council. A Form of Invitation Card was decided upon.
