Present: The President (Mr W. H. Middleton) in the chair Vice President Maxwell, Councillors Humphreys, Hurley, Herman, Martin, The Principal (Mr A. F. Heseltine) and the Art Principal (Mr H. H. Smith).

An apology was received from Mr Maddern at the request of the Chairman, the Art Principal stated the objects in view in drawing up the courses, as submitted to the meeting, was to enable Art School students to obtain recognition from the Council similar to that available to Science students.

Mr Martin agreed that some form of certificate should be issued; but that there should be a definite distinction between the Science and ^{Art} Diplomas or Certificates.

After further discussion it was resolved that the various courses be submitted to the Art Inspector (Mr P. M. Carey-Smith) for criticism & that after their approval had been received the conditions of issue be drawn up by the following Committee, The President (Mr W. H. Middleton) Councillors Humphreys, Hurley and Martin, The Principal (Mr A. F. Heseltine) and the Art Principal (Mr H. H. Smith).
