The Council then considered the matter of filling the position of Registrar and the applications of the four gentlemen (viz Messrs. Carney, Eby, Mauger and Robinson), who had been previously selected by the Finance Committee to be interviewed by the Council, were read. It was agreed that the selection of a candidate should be made by ballot and that the voting should be carried out by a process of elimination. The four applicants were then interviewed and the ballot conducted. The attached paper gives the details of the votes recorded and shows that the Council's preference was given to Mr. J. B. Robinson. His election was confirmed by the following resolution:-
