Meeting of Sub-Committee of Council
to arrange a conference with the
Ballarat Industrial Exhibition Committee
on the question of tuition of apprentices
in Plumbing Classes - held 30.7.23 7.30 p.m.
Present - The President (Mr W. H. Middleton)
in the chair, Vice President D. Maxwell,
C. J. Keane and The Principal (Mr A. F.
Herseltine).

The Committee discussed the various
aspects of the appointment of a qual-
ified Instructor in Plumbing, the
amount of salary available for the
position and the possibilities regarding
the attendances for a complete course
of study.

It was decided to interview the
local Exhibition Committee and the Ballarat
Sewerage Authority and ascertaining
the extent to which those bodies would
support this Council in reorganizing
the Plumbing Classes at the school.

Representations were subsequently
made to the Sewerage Authority by
The President (Mr Middleton) and Mr
Herseltine, with the result that this
Authority practically agreed to sub-
sidize the school for the purpose of
employing an expert Instructor,
provided an assurance could be
given regarding the number of
adult Plumbers who would attend
a Sanitary Engineering Class at
the school.
