Applications for the position of Instructor in Plumbing and Sanitary Engineering.

It was resolved to write to Messrs John Christie and D. E. Mullins asking them to visit Ballarat and interview the Committee.

The Committee again met on the 14th September ^{subsequent to} ~~after~~ interviews with Messrs D. E. Mullins and J. Christie.

It was resolved that Mr. John Christie be appointed as Instructor at a salary of £300/£324 plus £100 per annum subject to the sanction of the Hon. The Minister of Education.
