School of Mines wants the college established here and if not here will not agree to it being anywhere else. That is not true - The Committee gave the Government an estimate of the cost. We considered that estimate much too low - they left out altogether the question of dealing with office work, the equipping of an Office and the appointment of an office Staff. We have a complete organization to deal with this work - We have thousands of pounds worth of equipment in the engineering and science laboratories. Mr Hurley speaks about the University atmosphere.
