C. R. Madden Minutes of meeting held on 30th April 1924 were read and confirmed.

Accounts amounting to £1551-13-11 were recommended for payment.

A letter received from the Education Department advising the Council to adopt either the classification scale or pay a fixed salary to Miss Smith, office staff, and asking the Council to submit a recommendation on the above lines, was left in the hands of the President to interview the Department.

It was resolved that a refund of £2-12-6, term fees paid by student Mr. Dixon, Commercial Classes, who had obtained employment, be granted.

The offer of a second-hand typewriting machine equipped for mechanical adding etc, by Mr Chantres St was deferred.

It was recommended that the Certificate of Stock, £24 in the Melbourne Trust, held on behalf of the Deafiant Scholarship, be disposed of and the proceeds added to the main fund of
