Minutes of meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> May 1928 were read and confirmed.  
Accounts amounting to £1661.17.7 were recommended for payment.

In response to an advertisement in the Press for a Junior Teacher in the subject of Physiology, one application only, that of Mrs Mary Hereltine was received. It was resolved that Mrs Hereltine be appointed, subject to the Minister's approval, as from the beginning of the current term 28<sup>th</sup> May 1928 at a salary of 10/6 per session, one session per week.

In connexion with the Bank's Credit-Balance, referred to in the monthly financial statement presented to the meeting - it was resolved that the Registrar arrange with the Bank for the investment of surplus credits at interest on short-call, the interest derived therefrom to be added to the school's income.
