Resolved that the payment of staff salaries fortnightly as suggested by the Minister of Education was discussed. It was resolved that the President and Mr. Maddern inquire into the matter and report to the Council.

In view of the substantial credits periodically existing in the school current account at the Union Bank it was resolved to place a sum of £2500 on fixed deposit for twelve months at 4% interest and in consideration of this accept the Bank's offer of the 31st July 1928 to allow over-draft as may be required at $\frac{1}{2}\%$ over the rate carried by the fixed deposit.

It is estimated that an appreciable sum may be added to revenue by this means.
