to the pre vocational classes now in the process of formation at the Dana Rd school. It was proposed to enrol girls at the age of fourteen or fifteen for a course of academic preparatory study in general subjects including an Art Curriculum which was at present under discussion.

The course would probably be a popular one with girls when its advantages become known to the people of Ballarat. Vocational guidance would run hand in hand with this course of Post Primary Education.

The President drew attention to Mr Gill's early departure from this centre and in wishing him prosperity referred to his work in Educational matters during the past few years in Ballarat. Mr Gill gave generously of his time to Council meetings and had proved a great help to the Council. His interests were wrapped up with Post Primary Education and its relationship to Vocational guidance.

President It was moved that a record of Mr Gill's service on the Council be placed on the minutes of the meeting.

In replying Mr Gill stated that the voluntary help given by members of the Council was very stimulating and of great help to the Education Department.

The meeting closed with seasonal greetings and good wishes to members for a prosperous New Year from the President.
