The President extended a welcome
to Mr. Dean and stated that the
Council were at all times pleased
to receive the cooperation of the Inspectors
in the work of the school.

Mr. Dean, in reply, said that the
Art side of Technical Education was
at least as important as any other.
It was realized today - more so than
in the past, that the study of form
mass, line etc were closely associated
with the Engineering, Architectural,
Building Trades and Industries -
Their interests were closely interwoven.

Industrial and Commercial crafts
demanded a cultivation of a sense
of beauty such as that provided
in our Art Schools.

Incidentally Mr. Dean mentioned
that provision for the renovation
and improvement of the Dressmaking
Buildings of the school would be
made as soon as money was
available for this purpose.
