After discussion of various matters it was resolved that the following be recommended to the Council for adoption:

• SCHOLARSHIPS In place of six Junior Technical School Scholarships as at present for

1. BOYS 4 free and 4 at half fees be granted

GIRLS 2 free and 2 at half fees

EVENING STUDENTSHIPS (SCHOOL COUNCIL) :-

- All to pay half fees.

STATE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS 23 students in attendance Jan 1932. These scholarships to be further considered before renewal in 1933.

CITY COUNCIL GRANT £62.12.0 Fees of courses taken by holders of studentships under this Grant not to exceed the total of Grant.

STATE SCHOOL TEACHERS AND FREE TUITION

Education Department to be requested to allow the school to charge tuition fees

ART SCHOOL FEES Uniform fees to be changed

1. No distinction to be made in fees charged for students from different types of schools.
