Finance Committee Meeting.

Minutes of Finance Committee Meeting held in the School Council room on Wednesday the 18th March 1936 at 7-30 p.m.

Tues. Res. Sec.

Present. Mr. DeMarwell (Chair), Tues. Sec. Mr. J. Barrow the Hon. Treasurer Mr. A. Lederman, and His Worship the Mayor Mr. C. Martin, and the Principal, Mr. A. J. Keselbine.

Apology. Mr. Lederman apologized for the absence of the President, Mr. W. H. Middleton, through illness.

Minutes. The Minutes of the last Finance Meeting held on the 14th February 1936, were ^{read and} confirmed. (Mr. Lederman & Barrow)

Accounts. Accounts amounting to £ 1417-2-9 vide Chairman's Minute Book No. 55, were checked and recommended for payment (Mr. Barrow & Martin)

Financial Position. The Registrar reported that the Credit Balance at the Bank was £ 326-2-8 but after paying accounts recommended at this meeting there would be a Debit Balance of £ 550-4-10.

General. Mr. Lederman ~~has concluded~~ stated that owing to a new regulation regarding the analysis of milk samples submitted by the City Council the School's tests were not in compliance with the new regulations with the result that prosecutions by the City Council would fail. Tests by means of a new apparatus for determining the freezing point

were necessary and the question had arisen as to who should bear the cost of installing this apparatus in the School's analytical department. After a discussion between Mr. Lederman, Martin and the Principal, it was resolved that it be a recommendation to the Council Meeting that the cost of purchasing and installing this apparatus be borne by the School and the City Council on a 50-50 basis. (Mr. Barrow & Lederman)

This concluded the business and the meeting closed.
